WHO? Mrs. Kate Leonard was the prime mover behind the establishment of a YWCA in St. Catharines 90 years ago. She was honorary president and her husband was a main contributor to build the first YWCA at 56 Queen Street.

WHO? Elaine was president of the YWCA in 1981 when the YW opened its Residence for Women (later to become the Epworth Terrace Women’s Residence.)
